Classes for 2019

We will be holding our Faction Athletics Carnival on November 23, next term. It is always a great day for the family so we hope to see you there, cheering for your child/ren and faction.

With changes to the Interschool held at Pemberton DHS, we have also taken this opportunity to implement a few changes in our program.

In all events, boys and girls will be combined. Looking through the recent records, there is not a lot of difference in times and distances.

There will be a winner and runner-up medallion for the mixed 800m event and a champion and runner-up trophy for the mixed senior and intermediate competitors. Championship points will be collected from all individual events except the 800m.

First ribbons will only be given for team events and first to fourth ribbons for individual events. K/P students will get a participation ribbon for their running race and not for any other event.

Children will be in six to ten events during the day. Jumps and throws will be held on the same day as the track events.
